

The competitor's Take-Up Reel is structured to tighten and release the tension of the 3/16" vinyl coated cable of a Competitor Racing Lane. Two steal plates encapsulate a drum that works as the turning mechanism to tighten and loosen the lane.

The drum is inserted and fastened in place by a retaining bar and accompanied by a release latch to disassemble the tightness of the 3/16" vinyl coated cable.

Created by fastening 2 plates with 8 rivets. These plates encapsulate the Drum and the Release Latch. They encapsulate the Drum by 2 cross bars that are screwed into the Structure. Measuring 5" in length and 3 ½" in width. The 2 ½" "S" hook tops off the Take-Up Reel to attach the Competitor Racing Lane to a swimming pool eye hook. From the hook to the bottom of the Take – Up Reel, measures 7 ½" in length.
